### PROJECT ENGINEER

The company has a vacancy for an experienced project engineer to support the delivery of the SFPC Capital Programme currently being implemented throughout our facilities on the Shannon estuary.

#### **Main Responsibilities:**

Reporting to the Engineering & Port Services Manager, the Project Engineer will have responsibility for the site supervision activities in relation to engineering works for the delivery of the SFPC capital investment programme and his/her duties will include:

- Dealing with contractual matters on site related to civil, mechanical and electrical works;
- Liaising with Stakeholders;
- Assessing Contractor claims and writing reports on same;
- Verifying Contractor payment applications against work completed
- Assessing Contractor performance against Contractual KPIs
- Assessing Contractor submissions including method statements and preparation of clear comments on these
- Reviewing Contractor design submissions against Employers' requirements and preparation of clear comments
- Supervising works, keeping records, measuring, managing correspondence and contractual documentation
- Proposing suitable changes to design to improve saving, ease construction programme, enhance specification and quality of completion
- Managing project risk and project Health and Safety
- Co-ordinating and liaising with contracts manager, Site Engineers and services Co-ordinator to ensure that all subcontractors and site personnel have timely and accurate information, ensure compliance with drawings, specification, building regulations and good building practice
- Applying a sound commercial mindset to all aspects of the role
- Monitoring quality of workmanship and materials of construction projects
- Planning, maintaining and controlling financial administration of all construction work, maintaining maximum cost effectiveness

- Overseeing the day to day engineering maintenance of SFPC facilities, buildings and structures
- Other duties as may be assigned by the SFPC Engineering & Port Services Manager

### **Key Requirements:**

- Degree in Civil Engineering or an equivalent professional qualification in Engineering;
- Satisfactory knowledge of civil engineering works, building construction, and project management;
- At least 8 years satisfactory post graduate experience of which at least 3 years was in on-site supervision, contract administration and project management of civil engineering works
- Experience in the construction of port related projects, marine-related construction or similar works
- Capable of writing clear and concise reports and keeping works records;
- Proficiency in the use of computers in relation to document handling and production of reports
- Strong working knowledge of construction contracts;
- Attention to detail and ability to comply with Quality Assurance Management Systems is essential
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office packages such as Excel and Word
- Experienced in the use of project management software packages and AutoCad/equivalent

### **Desirable Skills and Experience:**

- Experience in managing the construction of major port/ marine/ road/ rail/ storage infrastructure through to successful commissioning.
- Experience in the assessment of tender variation claims, contractor submissions and payment applications.
- Excellent interpersonal communication skills.
- Excellent coordination and organisational skills.
