Shannon Estuary

Marine hydrographic and Geophysical Survey Works on the Shannon Estuary between Port Tarbert/Kilkerin Point

Planned Work Dates: 03/09/2020 to 10/10/2020

Working dates are progress and weather dependent and may change

1. Type of Activity: Marine hydrographic and geophysical survey works across the estuary between Port Tarbert and Kilkerin Point within the Shannon Estuary. The vessel will be operating on 12-hour shifts during the daytime using a variety of towed and hull mounted sensing equipment. The vessel will operate with a restricted ability to manoeuvre and will be operating in as shallow as safe to do so.

2. Duration of Activity: Survey works will be conducted from the vessel's arrival on the 03/09/2020 until departure on the 10/10/2020. During this period, the vessel will be operating within the area on a 12-hour basis during daylight hours.

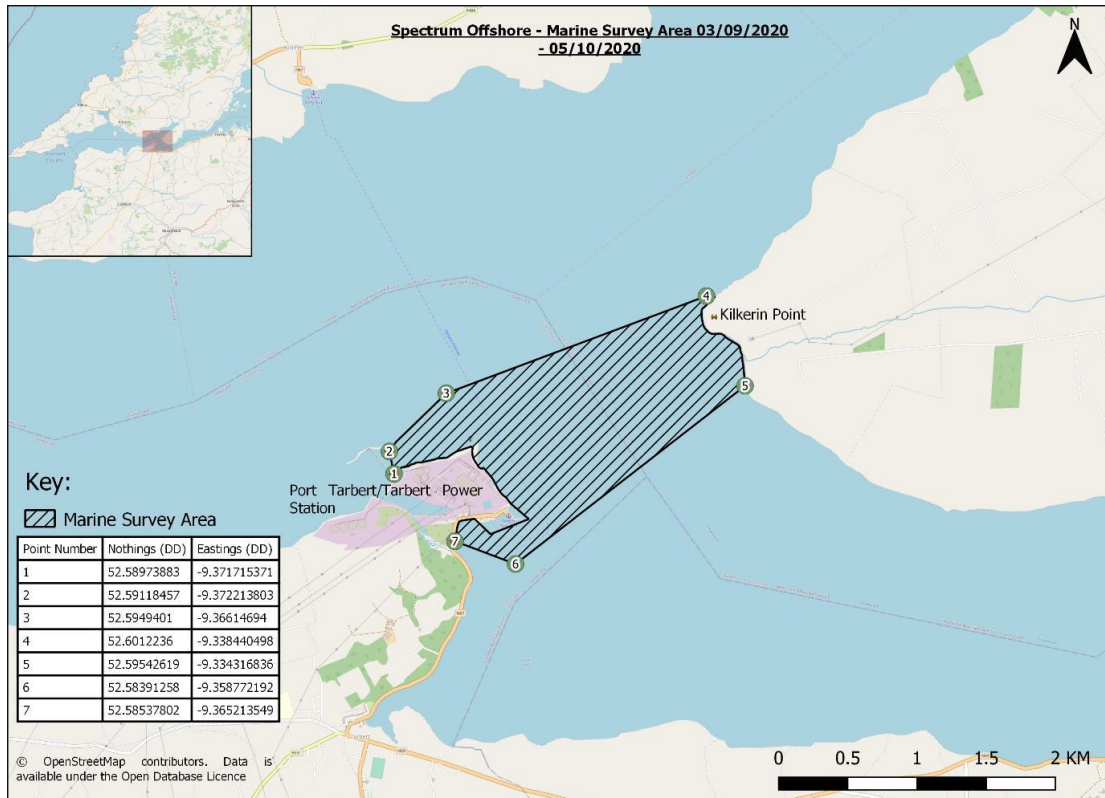
3. Location: Survey location is along a pipeline that crosses the Shannon Estuary from the Tarbert power station to Kilkerin Point. Survey works will be collected in the area shown in Figure 7. And into an inshore extent as shallow as the vessel can safely operate.

The vessels will be visible on AIS systems and will be monitoring and contactable via VHF radio on Channel 11 and 16. Crew members onboard will conduct a listening and visual watch and notify any vessels within the area of ongoing operations. In addition to this vessel mobile numbers are provided above for purposes of contact. Appropriate vessel signs will be flown displaying a restricted ability to manoeuvre.

Vessel will be in contact daily with Marine Operations to monitor movements and will adjust working to avoid impeding any vessels transiting Tarbert Race and will acknowledge vessels reporting at Glin and Moneypoint.
