



## **PORT MOBILE CRANE DRIVER (PERMANENT)**

With a strong commercial mandate, Shannon Foynes Port Company has statutory jurisdiction over all marine activities on the Shannon Estuary – Ireland's largest portal area. In addition to its terminal operations, warehousing and distribution networks, the Company governs the safe passage of all maritime traffic and port activity in the estuary, regularly accommodating vessels up to 200,000 tonnes.

We now have an opportunity for an experienced Crane Driver to join our highly motivated Port Services team operating out of our port facilities in Foynes and Ted Russell Docks in Limerick.

This is an exciting opportunity to be involved in a busy port. The focus of this position is the operation of cranes and associate equipment serving vessels at Foynes and Limerick. The principal cargoes handled by the company include coal, bauxite, animal feeds, oil products, recyclables, timber, steel and agricultural fertilisers.

The position is full-time with an annualised hours work pattern which means that the working week will vary but over 4 months will average a maximum of 48 worked hours. The weekly roster will include day-time, evening, night and weekend work, as well as out-of-hours on-call.

### **Key Duties will include:**

- Driving and operating Harbour Mobile and Crawler cranes employed in cargo loading/unloading on or off ships and / or landside lifting operations
- Safe use of Port Operations associated equipment such as forklifts, hoppers and vehicles
- Acting as Banksman / Signaller
- Compliance with safety regulations and Company safety policies
- Assisting in the general maintenance or upkeep of equipment such as cranes, forklifts, hoppers, vehicles etc.
- Maintaining plant, operational and EHS (Environmental, Health & Safety) records and reports
- Participating in Emergency response activities

### **Requirements:**

- Significant experience of operating large cranes, ideally in a dynamic environment such as a marine location or a busy construction site
- Availability to work out of hours on a Scheduled Roster basis
- Current valid full EU Driving License and the ability to work as part of a small diverse team are essential
- Current Safe Pass and relevant Crane tickets will be required to perform the role but training and certification will be provided where these are out-of-date
- Apprenticeship in a relevant Trade and experience of operating in a marine environment are all desirable but are not essential.

The successful candidate will be required to be flexible in the range of duties to be performed.
