## **NOTICE TO MARINERS**

### **NOTICE NO. 7 OF 2023**

## **SAFE SEAS IRELAND USERS**

Please be advised, that in accordance with Council Regulation (EU) No 833/2014 of 31 July 2014, as amended, vessels of any flag having statutory certificates issued by the Russian Maritime Register of Shipping (RMRS) will be refused access to Irish ports from 08/04/2023.

This is in addition to the previously introduced measure refusing of access to vessels registered in the Russian Federation.

Regulation 725/04/EC requires that vessels calling to Ireland must provide pre-arrival information which includes that the ship possesses a valid International Ship Security Certificate and the name of its issuing authority.

SafeSeasIreland will now no longer accept Pre Arrival Notifications for vessels having such a certificate issued by the Russian Federation or by RMRS.

Agents acting for vessels that have been issued a derogation as per the arrangements set out in Marine Notice 19 of 2022 should contact the Marine Survey Office accordingly.
