SHANNON ESTUARY – ASKEATON TO LIMERICK

Transit and Temporary Deployment of Tidal Energy Device

G-Kinetic plan to deploy their tidal energy device for demonstration purposes on a temporary basis during the approx. period Monday 18th September to Friday 22nd September. The device will be deployed downstream of the Sarsfield Bridge and adjacent to Limerick Boat Club.

The schedule for the deployment of the device as follows;

- a. Depart the River Deel Estuary on board the work boat Ard Ri at approx. 1700hrs on Friday 15th September and transit to Cahircon Pier where Ard Ri and unit will remain overnight.
- b. Commence transit from Cahircon to TRD Limerick at approx. 1300hrs on Saturday 16th September, arriving at the pm HW at TRD Limerick (approx. 1930hrs).
- c. Berth and remain at TRD until Monday 18th September.
- d. Depart TRD on the am HW on Monday 18th September (approx. 0815hrs) and proceed to planned mooring position adjacent to Limerick Boat Club.
- e. It is anticipated that the unit will remain on station until Friday 22nd September. Details around the subsequent transit of the unit will be advised in due course.

The unit will be both transported and deployed by the work boat Ard Ri.

Ard Ri will maintain a listening watch on VHF Ch11.
