NOTICE NO. 29 OF 2024

Moneypoint Hub Marine Geophysical Survey & Environmental Sampling

Green Rebel Marine will undertake a geophysical survey and environmental sampling campaign in relation to the Moneypoint Hub project in the Shannon Estuary in Co. Clare. The survey work is anticipated to run from **26 September 2024** to **13 October 2024**, subject to weather and operational constraints.

The locations of the survey works are as follows (see chartlet attached):

The survey will be conducted by the '**Lady Kathleen**' (Callsign: **EIXT2**). The vessel will display appropriate lights and signals. Geophysical equipment will be both hull-mounted and towed, comprising a multibeam echosounder, sub-bottom profiler, side-scan sonar and magnetometer.

The work will be conducted during 12 hr operations, during the hours of daylight only. It is intended that **Lady Kathleen** will mobilise from the marina at Kilrush on a daily basis.

Where possible, works will be scheduled to minimise impact on known vessel moves, in particular for deep draught vessels. The operators of the **Lady Kathleen** will liaise with Marine Operations on a daily basis to deconflict moves and operations.

Lady Kathleen will not be using buoys to mark out the area.

Lady Kathleen will be operating on:

- Ch 11 – Working Channel and maintaining watch on Channel 16.
